Also beginning July 1, Rev. Jean Blackie will serve as Administrative Pastor for Clark's Green. Rev. Blackie will also continue her ¾ time appointment at Dalton and Factoryville UMCs. Rev. Blackie's primary responsibility will be oversight of church administration, working closely and collaboratively with the Leadership Council and the church Administrative Assistant. You'll see Rev.
